



## Educational guidance

We set a lot of value on a high-quality educational guidance. In high-quality preparation meetings the participants are prepared for their projects thoroughly. After the encounter, a follow-up seminar offers the possibility to reflect experiences and make plans for future activities.

### Preparation and Follow-Up
