Despite the steps taken by the women to their emancipation, there remains a major social problem, as there are still differences between the two sexes, and despite the fact that many women are working professionals and their number is still very low in the various institutions. Noi voci di Donne is represented by only female people who has chosen to offer their knowledge, human and professional experience of women in need and without rights, listen their opinions, wishes and emotions, and trying to build a different future for them promoting and supporting their right to a better cultural, professional and political life, increasing women's participation in public life.

Our purpose is to develop the women presence in the social voluntary service, offering services in many fields. Our volunteer work is addressed to persons and their education, understood as a relationship of active help to facilitate awareness, freedom and women number consistency. Takes on particular significance in the context of listening and dialogue that allows the volunteer to share the condition of those women, who live in situations where is possible to give and receive emotional support, understand and experiencing the importance of listening and communication for to act against discomfort and psychological suffering, resulting by difficulties related to disability, disease, cultural disadvantages, marginalization, etc.

Foundation actively participates in international cooperation in order to gain knowledge and experience to fulfil organization's mission. Regular trainings, workshops, public cultural events and other activities are the methods that help to reach our aim.

In order to solve the youth re-emigration problems, foundation implements Youth in Action Democracy project “Go and Return!” that aims to activate youth participation in solving the youth re-emigration problems after gaining their knowledge in foreign universities in partnership with Estonia and Lithuania.

Regarding activities in National Level, Foundation for Society has been implemented national campaign with the support of USA Embassy – “Let’s be together!” – to help to prevent xenophobia and promote tolerance, together with national associations and cultural minorities, youngsters from orphanage-houses are engaged in popular education activities.

Der Berliner Arbeitskreis für politische Bildung (bapob) e.V. wurde 1980 von Politolog/innen und Pädagog/innen der FU Berlin gegründet, um gemeinsam emanzipatorische außerschulische Bildungsarbeit zu verwirklichen. Ziel war es, unabhängig von partei- und verbandspolitischen Vorgaben aktuelle Themen aufzugreifen und neue Formen des nicht-formellen Lernens in der politischen Jugend- und Erwachsenenbildung zu entwickeln.

Wichtige pädagogische Prinzipien unsere Arbeit sind Teilnehmer/innen-Orientierung, Prozess- und Zielgruppenorientierung sowie methodische Vielfalt. Weitere Merkmale unserer Arbeit waren und sind die grundsätzliche interkulturelle Perspektive sowie die kontinuierliche gemeinsame Weiterentwicklung unserer Konzepte. Thematisch widmeten wir uns von Anfang an Themen wie Ökologie, Friedens- und Entwicklungspolitik, Gender, Gesundheit, Umgang mit Gewalt, Rassismus und Rechtsextremismus.

Das Selbstverständnis des bapob ist gekennzeichnet von den Prinzipien der Selbstbestimmung und Selbstverwaltung. Wir teilen unsere Arbeit sowohl nach inhaltlichen Schwerpunkten als

auch nach Zielgruppen auf und versuchen dabei Hierarchien innerhalb des babob zu vermeiden.

Im Zentrum unserer Aktivitäten stehen seit Anfang an vor allem Angebote für Menschen, die sonst wenig Zugang zur politischen Bildung haben: sog. benachteiligte Jugendliche, Schulabbrecher/innen, Azubis, Arbeitslose. Ziel ist dabei immer, die Verbindung von gesellschaftlichen Strukturen und persönlichen Lebensrealitäten aufzuzeigen, den eigenen Standpunkt bewusst zu machen und kritisch zu hinterfragen, den Dialog zu fördern sowie zur Teilhabe am gesellschaftlichen Leben zu ermutigen und zu befähigen. Seit langem bietet der babob neben den Inlandsseminaren auch internationale Jugendbegegnungen und Fortbildungen an, die heute den Großteil unserer Arbeit ausmachen. Neben Berlin finden unsere Seminare hauptsächlich in Frankreich, aber auch in anderen europäischen und außereuropäischen Ländern statt, wie z.B. Spanien, Mazedonien, Türkei oder Algerien.
