Theater of the Oppressed is an innovative form of educational method, which is designed for the people, who don't have any experiences in acting or expressing themselves on the



stage. As an educational method can be used not only among homogeneous youngster groups, but also in the groups consisting of individuals with different cultural, religious and socioeconomic backgrounds. It enables to clarify values, develop social skills and solve the problems through invented characters and also to step in their shoes and see one personal situation or the situation of a particular group of persons from the other perspective.

Furthermore Theater of Oppressed techniques invites critical thinking and the dialogue between the participants. It is about analyzing rather than giving answers. It is also about “acting” (taking action) rather than just talking. With Theater

of Oppressed method participants can and often do discover empowering solutions to their own struggles. And they have a good time doing it. Learning and implementing the high adaptable techniques of the Theater of the Oppressed techniques can be immediately applied by youth workers, social workers, could work as a potential start of building and creating an environment of trust and mutual respect not only on the stage, but in everyday life.

The TC “Theater of the Oppressed: Implementation of forum theater methods in the youth work of dealing with the phenomenon of migration“ has focused on the phenomenon of migration, its significance and meaning for European society throughout history. The purpose of this training course to analyze and discuss such issues as lack of personal or community support mechanisms for migrants, which can be exposed to racism,
